Total Attendance: 9

504 students were enrolled on 100th day of school - per agreement with district we qualify for a full time Dean next school year

All of our grade levels are full

Benchmark scores are in and we had the TOP 4th grade math scores in the district

All scores were top in district overall, the schools that beat us only did so by 2-3 points

Classrooms getting all new metal doors with locking from inside capabilities - doors are in just waiting on hardware

Front office to be remodeled this summer with high security measures (ie bullet proof glass, no inner office door to Nurse Mary, door onto campus would require Mrs. Cyr to buzz it open, etc)

Treasurer - Current budget reconciliation shows us negative \$4k due to heavy fall expenses such as Aide salaries, Rosetta Stone and Chrome Book purchases - should be okay after Ultra Fun Run. Fall Giving raised \$16k, Classroom Baskets raised \$6k and WRU raised \$4700.00 (Katie)
